Secure-by-Design Foundations

Cloud programmes must meet ISO 27001, NIST, FCA, NHS DSPT, or sector-specific requirements. I build governance that ensures traceability, evidence, and auditability throughout delivery.



Managing Complex Dependencies

Regulated organisations often rely on legacy systems, third-party integrations, and critical services. I coordinate architecture, security, operations, and suppliers to ensure safe migration and operational continuity.
